To let you know just how expensive paid petitioners can be, the Constitution Party paid over \$10,000 to have Presidential Candidate Chuck Baldwin listed on Alabama's ballot. ALABAMA Legislation Alert!!

There is some GOOD NEWS on the home front.

HB 225/ HB48 Firearms, accessories, and ammunition manufactured in this state, under Commerce Clause of U. S. Constitution exempt from federal regulation, Firearms Freedom Act.

This will be Alabama version of the Montana Firearms Freedom Act. Will it have enough support in Alabama's democratic state house?

HB142 Cam Ward has reintroduced his petition requirements bill. Last year it passed committee, but Rep Ken Guin would not allow a vote on the measure. This would cut our petitions requirements in half.

We can also expect bills that will tackle Alabama's state sovereignty, a Healthcare Freedom Act, a Gambling ban, and a push from left wing liberals to rewrite our state constitution.

The Constitution Party of Alabama will not form an opinion on any pending legislation without reading the full context of each bill.

All party resolutions must be passed at convention by party members vote or by the executive state committee.
